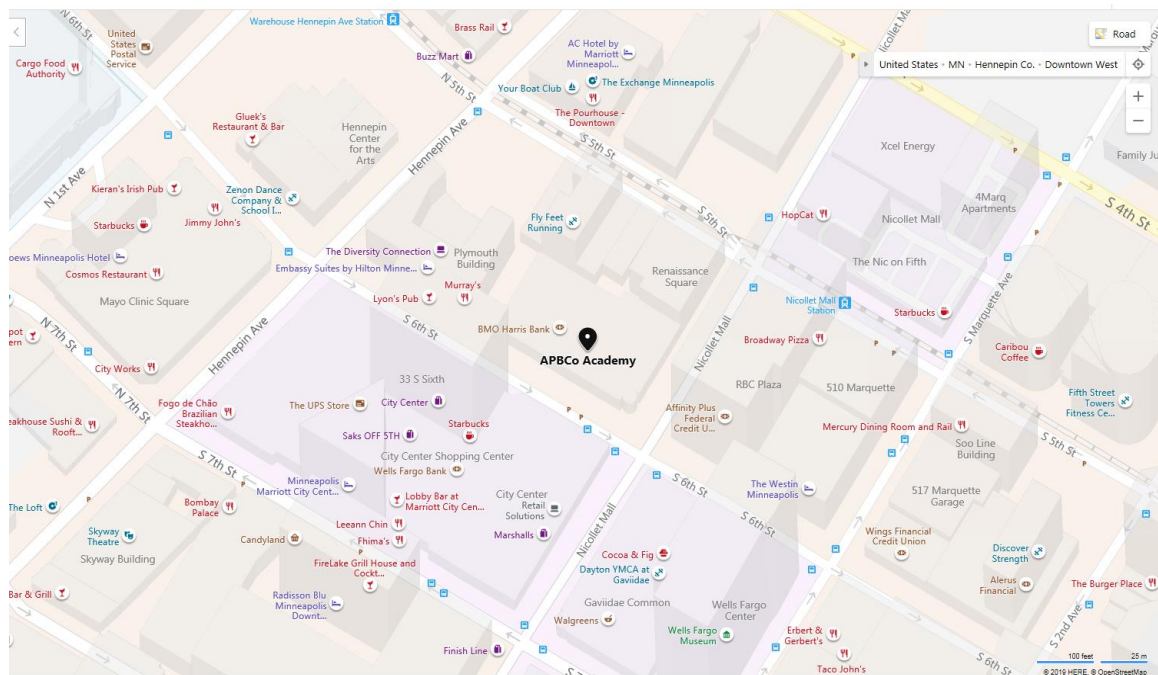
Other Hotels:
